- “IRM logistically too complex”
- Costs vs benefits, of both IRS and IRM
- Limited list of effective insecticides to choose from

Resistance monitoring and decision making tools:

- Resistance intensity assays?
- Resistance mechanism assays?
- Decision process, when identifying which VC intervention to make
- Decision making tools – decision trees?
- Funding
- Supply of materials for susceptibility assays
