

• Eritrea: Scope unclear


• Uganda: Phase I complete, Phase II in process

- Anticipated TA not being requested


### Reporting & quality control


 Draft and final reports are not being sent CReMA co-chairs for review and thus creating quality control issues

Country and Donor Engagement – Regulatory, NSP and Procurement Planning











The Global Fund is the largest procurer of commodities, essential drugs, and equipment utilized in HIV, TB, and Malaria programming

- Up to 50% of GFATM funds are utilized for procurement depending on the grant agreements and procurement plans
- PMI and other institutions account for the remainder not including country financed procurements
