## Introducing the SMC M&E Sub-Group

Purpose is to provide a platform where members of the SMC community can:

- share challenges and best practices in M&E
- discuss, collectively develop and harmonize tools

It is not intended that any SMC support will duplicate mechanisms that are already in place.

It will engage with groups working on SMC M&E.

First met on 6 November 2020; called for country participants at SMC Alliance annual meeting in February 2021; started working on SMC M&E Toolkit thereafter.







## Activities and plans of the SMC M&E Sub-Group

We have been discussing and agreeing on a set of standardized indicators for SMC

- Input, output, outcome and impact indicators defined
- Now combining them into a performance framework
- Next step translation into French and dissemination ahead of the 2021 SMC campaigns

- Continue with the SMC M&E toolkit (SMC Alliance annual meeting in February 2022)
- Support NMCP and WHO with the annual World Malaria Report chapter on SMC
- Continue to exchange ideas, outputs and gather feedback from a group of peers
