Malaria in pregnancy is a major public health problem, with ~11 million pregnancies exposed in Sub-Saharan Africa each year. Malaria in pregnancy can lead to miscarriage, premature delivery and poor future health outcomes for the child and mother.

Yet, only 1 in 3 eligible women take a full course of intermittent preventive treatment (IPTp) during pregnancy to protect both mother and child from malaria.

As we fight COVID-19, we must also act now to increase IPTp coverage and save lives.
