




## Current Displacement Challenges

The past two years have seen a sharp deterioration in the security situation

across Burkina Faso's northern and eastern regions due to the presence of

non-state armed groups.

Violence has resulted in the emergence of an unprecedented humanitarian

emergency in a country more traditionally subject to chronic food and nutritional insecurity.

Violence led to the displacement of more than one million people in just two

years and has left 3.5 million people in need of assistance, a 60% increase from Jan 2020 to Jan 2021.

Despite rains in 2020, food insecurity and malnutrition remain at alarming

levels, especially in areas affected by insecurity. More than 1.5 million people

118 deaths. Humanitarian needs are the highest since 2018, with 3.5 million

people in need of assistance.
